VACCINATION PASSPORTS HEALTH DIRECTIVES

As I am sure everyone is aware we will be required to ensure that all people, members and guests are vaccinated per the new Covid-19 health directives as follows for entry into the Branch:

- Proof of vaccination card and ID can be used up to September 27th. Vaccination Passport and ID can also be used.
- From September 27th a B.C. Vaccine passport plus ID will be required for all with minimum first dose of vaccine.
- From October 24th a B.C Vaccine passport and ID will be required showing receipt of second dose of vaccine.

All members who enter the branch for the first time prior to September 27th and show passports and ID indicating completion of 2 vaccine doses will be recorded and will not have to show on subsequent visits. All members who enter the branch prior to September 27th and only have first dose will be recorded as such and will have to show proof of second dose from October 24th forward.

All guests will have to show passport proof of vaccination on each entry with a member.

I know that we all understand that the health orders as directives are the law and legally binding on all business and organizations such as ours. The staff thus, will be just following and adhering to those legal requirements, so if there are any questions they need to be addressed to the B.C. Government Health Department not to the staff.

More importantly, it is for the Members, a procedure that ensures that all who enter are not going to be exposed to any unvaccinated persons and can continue to feel safe at the branch.

There are currently no exceptions to these Health Orders.

Thanks to all for continued great adherence to all current Covid health rules.
